What does my child need for camp?

- We will participate in the RSS Summer Food Program this year. This program provides each camper with breakfast and lunch (campers may still bring packed lunches). We will provide snacks in the afternoons.
- Extra change of clothing and socks (to leave for messy days).
- A water bottle or bottle of water (especially for outdoor field trips).
- Sunscreen: Apply at home and bring for use at camp.
- A blanket and pillow for quiet time, if they like.
- Be sure to label all of your child's belongings with his/her name.
- Please leave all extra toys at home. We have lots of things to do at camp!
- Electronics: Campers may bring electronics to camp, however they will be responsible for whatever they bring. ALL electronics must stay in airplane mode while at camp. For safety sake, campers will not be allowed on internet or use WIFI. This includes all iPods, iPads, iPhones, Kindles, and other such electronics. There will be designated times of our day that campers may use their electronics (Chill Time).

What should my child wear?

- Sunscreen, everyday.
- Campers should dress appropriately for a messy, dirty time!
- If your child wears flip flops to camp, please send socks and sneakers for outside play time and field trips.

Does my child need money?

- Campers are responsible for their own money.
- Spending money is optional. All field trip admissions are covered in the weekly fee.
- Concessions are available at the pool, bowling alley, movie theater, Village Park Splash Pad, Dan Nicholas Park, and a few of the other places we go. Prices vary.

What if my child does not swim well?

- All campers are required to demonstrate to the pool staff their swimming ability on their first day at the pool.
- Campers will have the opportunity for reevaluation of skills throughout the summer.
- Each camper will be shown where he/she can and cannot swim.
- If your child cannot swim well, he/she is not allowed to walk or play around the pool's deep end.
- Our ratio is 1 counselor to 12 children, plus 2 lifeguards.

Other information:

- Campers are rising 1st grade - rising 6th grade.
- Tuition** is due by the Thursday prior to each week your child is scheduled to be at camp.
Tuition is \$115 per week (\$225 per week for 2 children). Payments are always accepted in advance.
- We open at 7 AM. Please escort your camper in and sign them in. Campers will not be let in without an adult.
- Be sure to read any posted messages as you sign in/out each day.
- We close at 6 PM. You must come in to pick up your camper. Late fee of \$1.00/minute that you are late.
- There is a cancelation fee. If you must cancel a week that you have requested, please do so as soon as possible so that we may try to fill the vacancy. No fee if canceled at least TWO WEEKS prior to cancelation. If canceled within two weeks of the week, there is a \$25 cancelation fee.
- Camp schedules will be emailed by the Thursday prior to each week. All times for field trips will be included on schedules. We depart for most field trips between 9:30-10 AM and return by 2:00 PM unless noted otherwise on the weekly schedule.
- Summer Day Camp will be **CLOSED** the week of June 29 - July 3.
- RSS students return to school on August 4. The After-School Care Program begins on August 4.
