What is FUMC Summer Day Camp?

- Summer Day Camp is a fun and safe day of care for students who have completed K through 5th grade. We will have trips, games, outside times, academics as well as meals/snacks monitored by educational professionals.
- Summer Day Camp is offered for students **8 am until 5 pm**. Students will come to the entrance at door A5. They will buss to be let in and pick up is in the same place. Parents can call, text or use the buzzer to notify staff that they are there for pick up.
- Student will participate with the RSSS Summer Food Program which provides breakfast and lunch daily, and the SDC will provide 2 snacks daily. Students should bring a water bottle or bottle of water daily. We have the ability to refill them.
- Students should wear sunscreen daily.
- Students can bring electronics, but FUMC is not responsible for whatever they bring. Students are not allowed to access the internet or use WiFi (for safety reasons).
- Phones can not be used for calling, texting, pictures or videos.
- They should wear sneakers for outside play or for outdoor trips. You may want to send a change of clothes for messy days.
- Students may want to bring a pillow, blanket and a book for quiet time.
- All materials should be labeled with their name.
- All field trips are covered in the weekly tuition fee. If there is an opportunity for spending extras for snacks, etc, we will notify you in advance.
- Should a trip be planned and weather conditions should cause plans to change, an email and/or text message will be sent.
- The doors will open at 8 am and all students must be picked up by 5 pm. If they are picked up late, a \$10 fee will be charged. If this occurs again, a \$25 fee will be charged.

Swimming information

- On swim days, students will be required to demonstrate to the pool staff, their ability to swim on their first day at the pool.
- They will have opportunities to reevaluate these skills if needed.
- Swimmers will be shown where they can swim and where they are not allowed to swim.
- Swimmers who can not swim well will not be allowed to walk or play around the pool's deep end.
- The staff to student ratio is 1:12 or less not counting the lifeguards at the pool.

Fees

- Tuition is due when the students arrive on Monday mornings.
- If you sign up for camp and must cancel that time, please do so at least a week prior to the camp. This allows the staff to fill that space. If enough notification is not given, a \$25.00 cancelation fee will be charged.
- Students will leave FUMC between 9:30-10:00 am for most trips. We will be back on campus no later than 2 pm unless otherwise noted on the permission slip. A permission slip will be required for all trips.

- There is a \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee, due when registering your child which will hold a place for your student.
