

The Roy and Lula Goodman Scholarship

First United Methodist Church

Introduction

A Scholarship Fund was established in 1968 to assist church members with the expense of obtaining a college degree. The fund began with funds from the budget, memorial gifts and a later \$5,000 donation from Mrs. Dan Nicholas. An additional gift of \$100,000 was received towards the principal from Roy and Lula Goodman in December of 2001 in memory of their son, Larry. The principal balance in the fund is not to fall below \$105,000. Earnings on the principal or additional donations (not earmarked as principal) may be used to provide scholarship assistance.

In addition to the Scholarship Fund, the W.H. Leonard Fund's trust agreement provides that one-half of the earnings on its principal may be used for educational scholarship support of young persons.

Scholarship Committee

The nominations and personnel committee selects two at-large representatives to serve staggered three-year terms. The Senior Pastor and/or Associate Pastor, Business Administrator, Chairperson of Finance and Chairperson of Education also serve on the committee. The nominations and personnel committee appoints a chairperson from among the at-large membership.

The scholarship committee meets annually during the spring to review applications for scholarship awards. The committee will make the awards based on the criteria outlined in this policy and in conjunction with available monies on hand from the sources noted above.

Eligibility for scholarship awards

To be eligible to receive a church college scholarship award, one must be a current member of First United Methodist Church of Salisbury, be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate degree program of an accredited college, university or community college and have at least a 2.0 overall grade point average for the current school year. Persons of any age are eligible. Postgraduate's applications will not be considered. Applicants may apply each year as long as they are enrolled in an undergraduate accredited program.

Application Process

Scholarship availability will be advertised through the church newsletter annually no later than the first week of March. Scholarship application forms and copies of this policy will be available for pick up through the church office following the newsletter announcement. All completed applications, as well as any supporting materials, must be returned to the church office by the announced deadline. Incomplete applications or applications received after the announced deadline will not be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to verify receipt of completed application, including reference letters, with the church business administrator. The scholarship committee will hold all information in strict confidence.

A. Initial Applicants

1. Completed application with applicant's signature and the date on the back including an official transcript with GPA.
2. Essay, double-spaced, minimum of 150 words, describing what First United Methodist Church means to you.
3. Current (within the last year) character reference from a non-family member. This letter must contain date of composition along with information including email address or phone number.
4. An academic reference from the current school year. This letter must contain date of composition along with contact information including email address or phone number.
5. Participation in interview with scholarship committee members at a scheduled time.

B. Renewing Applicants (Those students who have been granted a previous scholarship)

1. Completed front of application with applicant's signature and date on the back, including an official transcript.
2. An academic reference from the current school year. This letter must contain date of composition along with contact information including email address or phone number.
